IET participated in the cultural fest organized by IIM,L. Dramatics team won the first prize in street play.

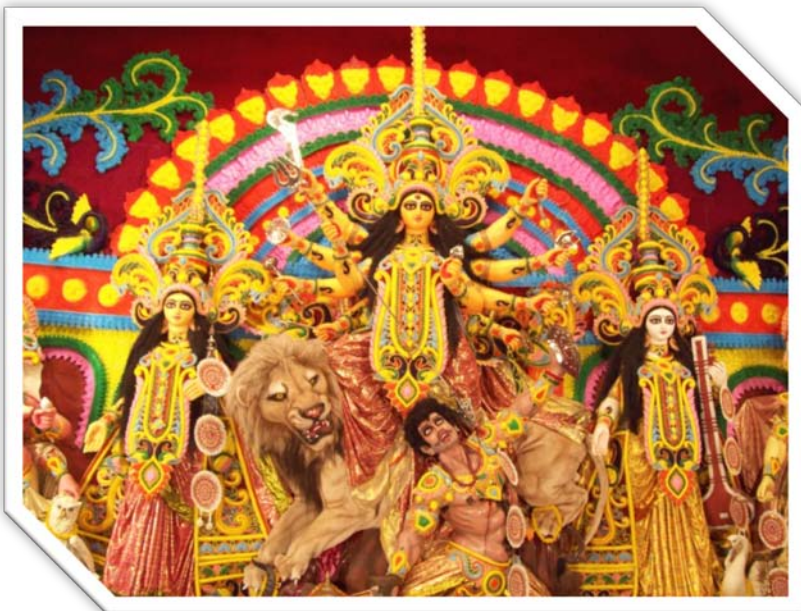


## BLOOD DONATION CAMP
